Home Club Service / Volunteer Policy 2011 - 2012



A Board of Directors runs the Northern Blades NSC FSC with many committees doing various duties; it is a non-profit, entirely volunteer club. The success of Northern Blades NSC FSC relies solely on the active and continuous support of its individual members and their families. The requirements for the 2011-2012 skating season are as follows:

- Each Home Club family will be required to provide 10 hours of service/volunteer time to the club during the fiscal year (June 1st through May 31st), families with more than one skating member will be required to provide 15 hours of service.
- A \$100 volunteer deposit is required from each Home Club Family to be cashed only if the family fails to fulfill the minimum required hours (10 hours for 1 skating member 15 hours for 2+ skating members) before May 20, 2012.
- Each member family will be required to report their hours before May 20, 2012 by completing the Volunteer Voucher available on the website and submitting the form to the Volunteer Coordinator.
- Hours not completed and reported by May 20, 2012 will not be counted.
- The volunteer deposit check will be returned upon full completion of the service/volunteer requirement. There are NO PARTIAL REFUNDS.

There are numerous opportunities to complete the required service/volunteer hours to the club. The 2 ISI competitions hosted in conjunction with the National Sports Center are the chief source of income to support the operations of Northern Blades NSC FSC (club ice fees, USFS testing, exhibitions, hospitality, annual banquet, test pins & awards, insurance and administrative expenses); without Summer Sizzle and Frosty Blades the club would need to either charge higher membership fees or require additional fundraising activities. In an attempt to distribute the volunteer time required for these major fundraisers equitably across families, we request that everyone participate in these events even in the event you do not have a skater competing.

Online registration for volunteering at the 2 ISI Competitions along with other events throughout the year will generally become available 3-4 weeks prior to each event. An email is sent out letting people know that the sign-up form is available. Committee appointments are generally available in July and August of the membership year.

ADDITIONAL HOURS

Members who work more than their required minimum may "trade-in" service/volunteer hours for random ice coupons. For every 5 service/volunteer hours worked beyond the required family minimum families will receive 1 random ice coupon, good for any available session on the NSC contract.

ADDITIONAL COMPETITIONS AND EVENTS

In the event Northern Blades NSC Figure Skating Club hosts an additional competition or event all home club members will need to contribute additional service/volunteer hours to the club. Members will be given notice of this requirement prior to the start of the Membership year in which the competition or event is scheduled to take place. These types of events and competitions help build the reputation of the club and typically provide additional revenue to the club. No additional competitions or events are planned in the 2011-2012 membership year.

ALL MEMBERS WILL NEED TO SUBMIT THEIR SERVICE/VOLUNTEER HOURS (STARTING JUNE 1ST) TO THE VOLUNTEER COORDINATOR, THIS INCLUDES ANY MEMBERS THAT WERE PREVIOUSLY EXEMPTED BECAUSE OF THE NUMBER OF HOURS THEY PUT INTO THE CLUB.
